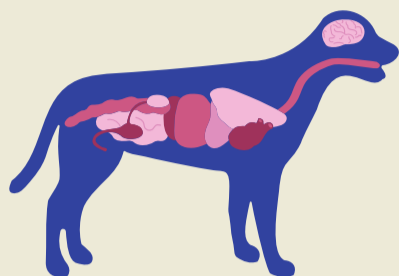


CANINE HEMANGIOSARCOMA



Hemangiosarcoma is a form of cancer that comes from the cells that normally make blood vessels.

FORMS OF CANCER

- **Visceral** – spleen, liver and other organs
- **Non-visceral** – muscle or skin (dermal)

DIAGNOSIS

- Physical exam
- Biopsy
- Diagnostic tests

TREATMENT

- Surgery
- Chemotherapy
- Radiation
- Supportive care

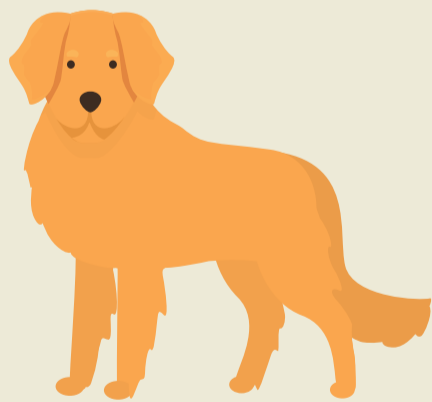


300,000

Golden Retrievers get hemangiosarcoma

Spayed females at 4X risk of intact females

PROGNOSIS

Weeks to months

Fewer than 1% of Golden Retrievers live for 1 year
